A Prayer A Day For God's World

Sunday Zimbabwe in all its needs: poverty, violence & corruption. Pray for the Unity Government & PM, Morgan Tsvangirai. Pray that Robert Mugabe will be able to control the worst elements of his ZANU-PF supporters; many people believe that at his advanced age he is not aware of things done in his name. Pray particularly about the 'blood diamond' mining in Marange, which, if the diamond business was managed well, could help restore prosperity.

Monday WBC's small group at **New Wine** this week. Pray for others on holiday that they be refreshed in body, mind & spirit, & for those who cannot go away because of family commitments, employment or financial pressures.

Tuesday Pakistan with its unstable government. The military are stronger than the elected civilian government of President Asif Ali Zardari; the army chief has had his term of office extended. The shadowy Inter-Services Intelligence (ISI) agency, which he previously headed, is widely believed to be supporting the Taliban in providing safe havens.

Wednesday Keep praying for our church group of 11 in **Lesotho**; that they will all remain healthy & safe & that the group will combine well, that they will be able to complete all the tasks that August & his team have set for them. Pray for encouragement as they see how much can be achieved in the work of the Lord in a country with so many needs & crying out for the gospel in deeds as well as words.

Thursday Pray regularly for the **Middle East** in all its strife & hostility. Pray that **Israel** will lift the blockade of **Gaza** completely, except for arms & munitions, allowing in materials for reconstruction as well as food for its impoverished people. Pray for continuation of diplomatic ties with surrounding countries to aid peace negotiations.

Friday Afghanistan, as information leaks out about NATO forces killing civilians as well as insurgents. In some areas, the Afghan National Police (ANA) are loathed more than the Taliban. In spite of NATO efforts to train them well, 90% of policemen are illiterate & have poor hygiene; their corruption, intimidation & habitual cannabis smoking are notorious. The Afghan National Army (ANA) are somewhat better, but nowhere near yet ready to replace foreign troops for adequate security.
