### A prayer a day for God's world

**Sunday: DR Congo**, for safety for the people of Goma & the North Kivu region amidst armed factions. Pray that the 18,500 troops of MONUC (the UN peace-keeping mission) will be effective against the rebel FDLR, a Rwandan Hutu militia. MONUC is the world's largest UN peacekeeping operation & it supports the Congolese army (FADRC) which itself has incorporated other groups, eg CNPD, known to have committed atrocities & recruited child soldiers.

**Monday:** Ian Thomson now in **Uganda & Sudan** to encourage churches & meet a bishop. He's particularly wishing to help in South Sudan, a very difficult area. He'll visit the US in March.

**Tuesday: Yemen**, now considered the West's new front against al-Qaida. It's a very poor tribal country with falling oil revenues & a strong Islamist opposition. The infrastructure, including schools & hospitals, is very poor. APAQ, al-Qaida in Arabian Peninsula, uses Yemen as its base to export terror, including the attempt to blow up an airliner over Detroit Christmas Day.

**Wednesday: DR Congo.** See Sun. Although it has been reported that conditions have improved in the last six months, continue to pray for peace & an end to terrorism & rape by militias. Pray that the groups incorporated into the Congolese army will be paid & that they will come under the proper military discipline of a professional army. Pray for Lyn & Jo Lusi & their colleagues in HEAL Africa & our group visiting Goma this summer.

**Thursday: Turkey**, constitutionally secular but with a strong Islamic element, wants to join the EU. About 2 weeks ago, a 16 year old girl was buried alive by her male relatives in a so-called 'honour killing'. Her offence had been speaking to boys at school. Pray against such crimes against girls & women in many countries, whether done by ancient tribal beliefs, religious beliefs or misunderstanding of religious beliefs.

**Friday:** The current debate in **GB** about **euthanasia**, assisted suicide & end-of-life decisions. There have been important & well-publicised court cases recently, eg Inglis & Gilderdale. Humanists have been very vocal in the media. Sir Terry Pratchett, who has Alzheimer's disease, has been prominent in support of assisted suicide. Pray for reasoned debate generally & for Christian contributions which are both rigorous & compassionate.
