A prayer a day for God's world

Sunday: Relations between **India and Pakistan** deteriorated sharply following the terrorist attacks in Mumbai in 2008 and peace talks between the two countries were suspended. Peace negotiations are due to resume this Thursday. Pray that they will not be derailed by further terrorism, and for a reduction of tension between the two countries.

Monday: Hundreds of thousands of people in **Haiti** are still without shelter and sanitation following January's earthquake. There is a serious threat of disease as the rainy season approaches. Pray that further funds would be donated, particularly to purchase tents, and for the work of relief agencies on the ground.

Tuesday: Tension has been rising between Argentina and the UK over oil exploration in the waters off the **Falkland Islands**. Pray that the issue will be resolved peacefully.

Wednesday: Unemployment rates in the **UK** remain high, with the number of long-term jobless continuing to rise. 1600 steelworkers on Teeside were due to lose their jobs last Friday. Pray for individuals and families who are having to cope with unemployment or the threat of it, and for politicians and business leaders as they seek ways to increase employment opportunities.

Thursday: In **Uganda and DR Congo**, rebel groups continue to recruit child soldiers by force. Pray for an end to this practice; and for the tens of thousands of children in these countries and others such as Sri Lanka and Sierra Leone who have been emotionally damaged over past decades by being forced to commit mutilation and murder.

Friday: Iain and Emma in **the Middle East**.

Saturday: Pray for the safety and release of hostages, often forgotten because they are out of the news headlines, who are being held by terrorist and rebel groups in **Nigeria, Somalia, Colombia, Iraq & other countries**.
