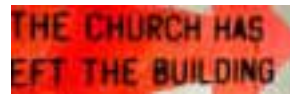

**A prayer a day for God's world**

**Sunday:** Madeira, where there were floods & mud landslips last weekend, with many killed & injured. Pray for the bereaved; pray for those injured or left homeless; pray for rescue & restoration work.

**Monday:** Heather & Barry, & Carol & David now in Lesotho for 2 weeks, helping August Basson & the Growing Nations team. Pray that their various gifts in administration, accountancy, photography, DIY etc may be used to the full there & that there will be good co-operation & spiritual encouragement.

**Tuesday:** The millions of people affected by the economic downturn. Within Europe, Greece is particularly badly affected. The government has introduced strict economic policies & there has been a vigorous response in Athens. Pray for the necessary strict economic management, but which is also fair & equitable. Pray for social cohesion with no violence on the streets.

**Wednesday:** Ian Thomson, presently visiting Sudan & Uganda, then going to USA. Pray for the development of Christian missions in many needy parts of Africa, especially to displaced people. Darfur has been less in the news recently, but, as in so many other countries, there are still enormous problems of poverty & marauding militia groups who kidnap, mutilate & rape.

**Thursday:** Northern Ireland after the recurrence of bombing, which many politicians on all sides have condemned & say is like going back to the bad old days. The bombs are thought to be the work of dissident nationalists disappointed by recent negotiations about NI Assembly control of the police & justice system. Pray for peace & an end to this recent outbreak of violence.

**Friday:** Afghanistan, for the allied troops serving there & for their training of local Afghan troops to take over their role. Pray particularly for the political situation with elections coming soon. President Hamid Karzai has appointed only members of his own government to the Electoral Commission, thus ending independent assessment of elections. Pray for an end to corruption, which is so prominent in Afghanistan, including at the last election.

**Saturday:** Christian pastors, evangelists & believers who are in prison for their faith in many countries, including Burma, China, Eritrea, North Korea, Pakistan & Vietnan.
