A Prayer A Day For God's World

Sunday For the complete plugging of the oil leak on the **Mexican Gulf** & its shoreline as soon as possible. The area was recently affected by hurricane Alex, the first of the season, which caused many ships to abandon clearing oil & led to the booms being made ineffective by heavy seas.

Monday After last weekend's meetings of the G8 & G20, pray for effective management of the **worldwide economic recession**, which affects everyone but which has most impact on poor countries. Countries adopted different strategies according to their own debts etc. Pray that all decisions taken will avoid the feared 'double dip recession'.

Tuesday Sudan which has been struck by war, persecution, hunger & disease. The mainly Christian people of South Sudan (which is 3 times the size of Britain) suffered grievously in the brutal civil war of 1983-2005 which completely destroyed its infrastructure. The north has an Islamic government & sharia law.

Wednesday Turkey: the Kurdish area in the east which crosses country borders eg into Iraq. Kurdish rebel separatists (the PKK & its offshoots) are active in their own area & also in Istanbul where 2 weeks ago they exploded a remote-controlled bomb next to a bus carrying military personnel, killing 5 & wounding 12. Although the country is constitutionally secular, it is largely Muslim & unreached by the gospel. Now there are few Christians, although it was a bastion of Christianity for over 1000 years.

Thursday Pray for WBC's 5 intrepid people going to **DR Congo** from 16th-31st of this month - Ewen, Fenella, Nick, John & Martin. Pray for their preparation, that there will be no difficulties in travel or with safety & that they will achieve a lot in their short time. Pray that they will return healthy, encouraged by their experience & ready to tell us of God's work there.

Friday Sudan (see Tues). In spite of persecution, churches in the south have had massive growth. Believers in the north suffer discrimination & severe restrictions. A peace agreement has been signed between North & South & next year the South is due to vote on becoming an independent country - the choice could bring instability or renewed conflict.

Saturday China, especially **Tibet** which has a poor human rights record; dissidents are maltreated & family life suffers from the one child policy.
