**A Prayer A Day For God's World**

**Sunday Afghanistan.** We have recently heard of the death of the 300th British soldier there. Pray that the killing will come to an end. Against current trends, pray that British & NATO troops will be able to go home soon, leaving Afghanistan in a better state, peaceful, & with a sound, incorrupt government.

**Monday Kyrgystan.** The more news comes out, the worse the situation seems to be. It is now thought that over 2,000 people have been killed, many more injured & huge numbers of people displaced in the south after ethnic violence between Uzbek & Kyrgyz groups.

**Tuesday Southern China** where floods caused devastation last week. Over 130 people died & hundreds of thousands had to flee. Millions of people have lost property & even more were without power or water supplies. There was the worst drought in living memory in the same area earlier this year.

**Wednesday** See Tues. Pray also for **Brazil**, where over 1,000 people were missing after floods struck small towns & cities in the north-east region, also last week. Many more people are left homeless. Pray also for southern **France** which too has been affected badly by floods recently. Expand the prayers to include victims of other natural disasters in other countries, often not reaching publicity in our media.

**Thursday Mozambique**, one of the poorest countries in Africa, with a very high incidence of HIV/AIDS & still a large refugee population after the guerrilla wars until 1995. Before 1992, Marxist/Leninist governments strongly aimed for 'destruction of religious superstition', but there is now religious freedom & a thriving church, with the fastest church growth in black Africa in the 1990s. Severe floods in 2000 & 2001 stimulated Christian assistance & planting of churches in refugee camps. Pray for local churches, for training of church leaders & for provision of much-needed scriptures.

**Friday** Peace in the **Middle East**, both for the sake of its own people & because peace there is key to wider international peace issues. Pray for Tony Blair, the envoy of 'the quartet', for US Secretary of State Hillary Clinton & for many others in their efforts towards a settlement between **Israel & Palestine** (West Bank & Gaza).

**Saturday** Pray against **drug smuggling** eg in the Caribbean & the Far East, where drug smugglers affect governments & also finance rebel movements.
