A prayer a day for God's world

Sun: Chile after the earthquake on 28th Feb followed by further damage from tsunamis. Over 700 people have been killed with tens of thousands left homeless. After the initial delay, pray that aid will get through where needed, including some remote areas; there will be no looting & that the armed forces deployed will be needed only for humanitarian help.

Mon: The Baileys & Manns in **Lesotho** with the Bassons & the Growing Nations team. Last Friday, they had an International Supporters Day in Maphutseng to demonstrate the impact of Conversation Agriculture on the fields & crops. Pray that the effect will be widespread in many countries & very fruitful in the long term. Pray for the return journeys on the 13th & 18th.

Tues: Iraq, just after the General Election 2 days ago in a country which has been chaotic & riddled by corruption, including the Prime Minister, Nour al-Maliki, handing out guns to tribal leaders in a bid to win votes. At the time of writing it was thought that the election would show that al-Maliki would need to find coalition partners with other parties who would not countenance him continuing as Prime Minister. Pray for a peaceful outcome & for a fair & representative government.

Weds: See Sun. Continue to pray for other countries where there have been natural disasters, but which are not now in news bulletins, particularly **Haiti** where reconstruction work will be needed for several years. Pray for emotional healing, as well as for physical & economic recovery. Keep mindful & prayerful for other disaster & war-torn areas eg **DR Congo** after the initial impact has died down.

Thurs: Darfur. Only a few days ago, Sudan's President declared the war was over, but heavy fighting has again broken out between government & rebel forces. Tens of thousands of people have fled their homes in a remote, mountainous region after a military offensive against the Sudan Liberation Army. Humanitarian agencies were withdrawn for safety a few weeks ago.

Fri: Efforts worldwide to eliminate **malaria**, particularly in **Africa**. Half of the world's population is still at risk with nearly 1 million deaths per year. Pray for greater access to mosquito nets. The development of better medications & more access to current drugs. Pray for international co-operation to achieve these goals.

Sat: Continue to pray for the **Peace of Jerusalem**, & for Israel & Palestine more generally.
